

Queens High School (384)
Enrolment Scheme
Commences 01 January 2026

The guidelines for development and operation of enrolment schemes are issued under Schedule 20, Clause 3 (3) of the Education and Training Act 2020 for the purpose of describing the basis on which the Secretary's powers in relation to enrolment schemes will be exercised.

Home Zone

All students who live within the home zone described below shall be eligible to enrol at the school.

The Home Zone includes addresses on both sides of the boundary roads mentioned in the description unless otherwise stated.

Starting from the intersection of Victoria Road and Queens Drive, the home zone follows:

- South-east along John Wilson Ocean Drive until the end of John Wilson Ocean Drive
 - Including kettle Park Road
- From the end of John Wilson Ocean Drive jumps south to the coastline
- East and then north along the coastline of the Otago Peninsula until online with the northern end of Harington Point Road
- South along Harington Point Road until Portobello Road
 - Including all side streets off Harington Point Road
- West along Portobello Road until Portsmouth Drive
 - Including all side streets off Portobello Road
- North-west along Portsmouth Drive until Strathallan Street
- South-west along Strathallan Street until Andersons Bay Road
- North-west along Andersons Bay Road until the Caversham Bypass Motorway
- South-west along the Caversham Bypass Motorway until Caversham Valley Road
 - Including Leckhampton Court between the Caversham Bypass Motorway and St Heliers Court,
 - Including Bridge Street,
 - Including St Heliers Court,
 - Including Barnes Drive,
 - Including Sydney Street,
 - Including Shortland Street,
 - And including Lancefield Street
- West along Caversham Valley Road until the Dunedin Southern Motorway
 - Including Aberfeldy Street,
 - Including Thomson Street,
 - Including Lindsay Road,
 - And including Balance Street
- West along the Dunedin Southern Motorway until on line with Carnforth Street
- North along Carnforth Street until Neill Street
 - Including Boomer Street and all the side streets off of it,
 - And including Carnforth Street to the north of Neill Street

- West along Neill Street until Christie Street
- North along Christie Street until the end of Christie Street
 - Including Edward Street,
 - And Including Mitchell Street
- From the end of Christie Street jumps north to the end of Abbots Hill Road
- West along Abbots Hill Road until North Taieri Road
 - Including McMeakin Road
- North-west along North Taieri Road until the end of North Taieri Road
 - Including Abbeyfield Close,
 - And including Freeman Close
- From the end of North Taieri Road jumps west to the end of Flower Street (by 120 Flower Street)
- South along Flower Street until Martin Road
- West along Martin Road until Main Road
 - Including Centennial Road,
 - And including Freyberg Road
- West along Main Road until Morris Road
 - Including Main Road to the west of Morris Road,
 - And including Saddlevue Place
- North-west along Morris Road until Chain Hills Road
 - Including Coach Road
- East back along Morris Road and Main Road until Old Brighton Road
- South Old Brighton Road until McMaster Road
- From the corner of McMaster Road and Old Brighton Road jumps west to the end of Creamery Road
 - Including McMaster Road
- South-west along Creamery Road until Brighton Road
 - Including John Street
- South-west along Brighton Road until Edna Street
- North-west along Edna Street until Kayforce Road
 - Including Hare Road
- West along Kayforce Road until Bennett Road
- South along Bennett Road until the end of Bennett Road
- From the end of Bennett Road jumps south-east to Brighton Road
- South-west along Brighton Road up to and including 940 Brighton Road
- From number 940 Brighton Road travels east back along Brighton Road until Blackhead Road
 - Including all side streets off Brighton Road between 940 Brighton Road and Blackhead Road
- South-east along Blackhead Road until Green Island Bush Road
- North-west along Green Island Bush Road until Church Hill Road
- North-west along Church Hill Road until District Road
- East along District Road until Quarry Road
- From the intersection of District Road and Quarry Road jumps east to the end of Prosser Street
- North along Prosser Street until Shanks Street
- East along Shanks Street until Price Street
- North along Price Street until Main South Road
- West along Main South Road until Orange Street
- North along Orange Street until the end of Orange Street
- From the end of Orange Street jumps north to the Dunedin Southern Motorway
- East along the Dunedin Southern Motorway until Caversham Valley Road

- East along Caversham Valley Road until South Road
- South-east along South Road until Riselaw Road
 - Including all of South Road to the west of Riselaw Road
- South-east along Riselaw Road until Corstorphine Road
 - Including all side streets off the western side of Riselaw Road
- South along Corsorphine Road until Middleton Road
- East along Middleton Road until Isadore Road
 - Including Bruntsfield Place
- South-east along Isadore Road until Highgrove
- South along Highgrove until the western end of Highgrove
- From the western end of Highgrove jumps south to the coastline
- East along the coastline until Moana Rua Road
- North along Moana Rua Road until Victoria Road
- East along Victoria Road until Queens Drive

Each year, applications for enrolment in the following year from in-zone students will be sought by a date that will be published by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school. This will enable the board to assess the number of places that can be made available to students who live outside the home zone.

Special Programmes

This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a Special programme approved by the Secretary.

Additional Entitlement to Enrol (Grandparenting)

For families of currently enrolled students whose addresses become out of zone as a result of the implementation of this Enrolment Scheme.

Section 75 of the Education and Training Act 2020 states that;
“the Secretary may authorise an enrolment scheme to permit a student to enrol at the school as if the student lived in the home zone of the school if, -

- (b) in the case of a new enrolment scheme, the student—
- (i) lives outside of the home zone of the new enrolment scheme; and
 - (ii) has a sibling who is enrolled at the school at the time that the new enrolment scheme is implemented.”

The **Transitional arrangements (“Grandparenting”)** section within the **Guidelines for the development and operation of enrolment schemes for State Schools** further clarifies that in order to enrol as if the student lived in the home zone:

- (i) The sibling must also still be enrolled at the school at the time that the student wants to enrol

If applying for enrolment under this part of the Enrolment Scheme, the sibling’s name and evidence of a sibling relationship may be required by the school.

[Section 75](#) of the Education and Training Act 2020 sets out the definition of a “sibling” for these purposes.

The school will maintain a list of students enrolled at the time of the implementation of the enrolment scheme by the Board in order to enable determination of eligibility to enrol under this provision.

Out of Zone Enrolments

Each year the School Board will determine the number of places which are likely to be available in the following enrolment period(s) for the enrolment of students who live outside the home zone. The Board will publish this information by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school. The notice will indicate how applications are to be made and will specify a date by which all applications must be received.

Applications for enrolments will be processed in the following order of priority:

<u>First Priority</u>	This priority is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a special programme approved by the Secretary for Education.
<u>Second Priority</u>	will be given to applicants who are siblings of current students.
<u>Third Priority</u>	will be given to applicants who are siblings of former students.
<u>Fourth Priority</u>	will be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school.
<u>Fifth Priority</u>	will be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the board of the school or a child of a member of the board of the school.
<u>Sixth Priority</u>	will be given to all other applicants.

If there are more applicants in any priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by ballot conducted in accordance with [instructions by the Secretary](#), under [Schedule 20, Clause 3 \(1\)](#) of the Education and Training Act 2020. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school.

Applicants may be required to give proof of In Zone address, or proof to support their application if seeking enrolment under the Out of Zone priorities.
