




**Hedgehope School (3964) –New Enrolment Scheme

Summary of Response to Feedback**



Theme	Comment	Response
Geographical Boundaries	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Some areas are excluded from the home zone.• Concerns over excluding certain areas would disadvantage nearby families	The home zone was reviewed, and the areas were not included as this could increase enrolments beyond the school's capacity.
Roll cap too low	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Concern that the proposed roll of 50 students is seen as insufficient• Risk of losing the third classroom which is considered essential for a Year 1-8 school	The Ministry funded teaching spaces at Hedgehope School is two, this gives an approximate capacity of 50. The school board can manage their capacity around the figure of 50 students.
Staffing and resourcing	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Concern that it is essential to have three classrooms for staffing	An enrolment scheme is not connected to staffing, it is a mechanism to help manage capacity at a school.
Community connections	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Concern that changes could affect future students	If the school has out of zone places, it can advertise for enrolments outside of its home zone. Siblings of current students are top of the priority list for out of zone students if the school does not have a special programme.
