



Hedgehope School (3964)

Enrolment Scheme

Commences 26 January 2026

The guidelines for development and operation of enrolment schemes are issued under Schedule 20, Clause 3 (3) of the Education and Training Act 2020 for the purpose of describing the basis on which the Secretary's powers in relation to enrolment schemes will be exercised.

Home Zone

All students who live within the home zone described below shall be eligible to enrol at the school.

The Home Zone includes addresses on both sides of the boundary roads mentioned in the description unless otherwise stated.

Starting from the southern end of Horton Road, the home zone follows:

- North along Horton Road until its intersection with Wilsons Crossing Road and Pettigrew Road
- North along Pettigrew Road until Crowe Road
 - Including Wilsons Crossing Road to the west of Horton Road and Pettigrew Road intersection up to and including number 21 Wilsons Crossing Road,
 - And including Pettigrew Road to the north of Crowe Road
- South-east along Crowe Road until Springhills Tussock Creek Road
- South-east along Springhills Tussock Creek Road until Sharks Tooth Road
 - Including Springhills Tussock Creek Road to the north of Sharks Tooth Road up until and including number 394 Springhills Tussock Creek Road,
 - And including Morris Road
- East along Sharks Tooth Road until the Winton Hedgehope Highway
- South-east along the Winton Hedgehope Highway until Mako Road
 - Including the Winton Hedgehope Highway to the north of Sharks Tooth Road up to and including number 1575 Winton Hedgehope Highway
- North along Mako Road until Frisby Road
- East along Frisby Road until the end of Frisby Road
 - Including Mako Road between Frisby Road and Springhills Siding Road
- From the end of Frisby Road jumps east over the Otapiri Stream to Keen Road
- North along Keen Road until the end of Keen Road
- From the end of Keen Road jumps north until the intersection of Jewitt Road and Scott Road
- South-east along Jewitt Road until Murchison Road
 - Including Menzies Road between Jewitt Road and William Road
- North-east along Murchison Road until Dunsdale Valley Road
- North along Dunsdale Valley Road until the end of Dunsdale Valley Road
 - Including Hokonui Road
- From the end of Dunsdale Valley Road jumps east to where Wilson Road turns into Lawrence Road

- West along Wilson Road until the Glencoe Highway
- West along the Glencoe Highway until Brydone Glencoe Road
- South along Brydone Glencoe Road until Pebbly Hill Road
 - Including 1427 Brydone Glencoe Road
- South-west along Pebbly Hill Road until West Road
- South along West Road until the end of West Road
- From the end of West Road jumps south to 537 Mabel Woodstock Road
- West along Mabel Woodstock Road until Robertson Road
- South along Robertson Road until Mabel Grove Bush Road East
- West along Mabel Grove Bush Road East until Rakahouka Hedgehope Road
- West along Mabel Grove Bush Road West until the end of Mabel Grove Bush Road West
- From the end of Mabel Grove Bush Road West jumps north to the end of Horton Road

Each year, applications for enrolment in the following year from in-zone students will be sought by a date that will be published by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school. This will enable the board to assess the number of places that can be made available to students who live outside the home zone.

Special Programmes

This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a Special programme approved by the Secretary.

Out of Zone Enrolments

Each year the School Board will determine the number of places which are likely to be available in the following enrolment period(s) for the enrolment of students who live outside the home zone. The Board will publish this information by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school. The notice will indicate how applications are to be made and will specify a date by which all applications must be received.

Applications for enrolments will be processed in the following order of priority:

First Priority

This priority is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a special programme approved by the Secretary for Education.

Second Priority

will be given to applicants who are siblings of current students.

Third Priority

will be given to applicants who are siblings of former students.

Fourth Priority

will be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school.

Fifth Priority

will be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the board of the school or a child of a member of the board of the school.

Sixth Priority

will be given to all other applicants.

If there are more applicants in any priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by ballot conducted in accordance with [instructions by the Secretary](#), under [Schedule 20, Clause 3 \(1\)](#) of the Education and Training Act 2020. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school.

Applicants may be required to give proof of In Zone address, or proof to support their application if seeking enrolment under the Out of Zone priorities.
