

Wyndham School (4054)
Enrolment Scheme
Commences 26 January 2026

The guidelines for development and operation of enrolment schemes are issued under Schedule 20, Clause 3 (3) of the Education and Training Act 2020 for the purpose of describing the basis on which the Secretary's powers in relation to enrolment schemes will be exercised.

Home Zone

All students who live within the home zone described below shall be eligible to enrol at the school.

The Home Zone includes addresses on both sides of the boundary roads mentioned in the description unless otherwise stated.

Starting from the intersection of Island Edendale Road and Edendale Wyndham Road, the home zone follows:

- East along Edendale Wyndham Road until Coal Pit Road
- North-east along Coal Pit Road until Johnston Road
 - Including Coal Pit Road between Johnston Road and Pioneer Highway
- North-east along Johnston Road until the end of Johnston Road
- From the end of Johnston Road jumps north-east over the Mataura River to the intersection of Wyndham Road and Chalmer Road
- South-east along Wyndham Road until Mimihau School Road
 - Including Oughton Road between Wyndham Road and Davidson Road
- East along Mimihau School Road until Waiarikiki Mimihau Road
 - Including Burns Road,
 - Including Arnott Road,
 - Including Diack Road,
 - And including McMillan Road
- East along Waiarikiki Mimihau Road until Venlaw Road
- East along Venlaw Road until the end of Venlaw Road
- From the end of Venlaw Road jumps south-west to the end of Egremont Road
- South-west along Egremont Road until Wyndham Mokoreta Road
- South along Wyndham Mokoreta Road until Wyndham Station Road
 - Including Boundary Creek Road,
 - Including Rodgers Road,
 - And including Mokoreta Esplanade and all the side streets off of it
- East along Wyndham Station Road until Foster Road
 - Including Wyndham Station Road to the east of Foster Road up to and including number 881 Wyndham Station Road
- South along Foster Road until Murray Road
 - Including Foster Road to the north of Wyndham Station Road
- West along Murray Road until Wyndham Mokoreta Road
 - Including Murray Road to the east of Foster Road,
 - And including Macale Road
- West along Wyndham Mokoreta Road until Mokoreta Tahakopa Road
- South-west along Mokoreta Tahakopa Road until Matheson Road

- Including Mokoreta Tahakopa Road to the south-east of Matheson Road up to and including number 725 Mokoreta Tahakopa Road
- West along Matheson Road Klondyke Road
- North along Craig Road until Wyndham Valley Road
- West along Wyndham Valley Road until Rabbidge Road
- South along Rabbidge Road until Stout Road
- South-east along Stout Road until Tyneholm Road
 - Including Hunter Road
- South-east along Tyneholm Road until Woodslea Downs Road
- South and then west along Woodslea Downs Road until Howe Road
 - Including Gibb Road
- North along Howe Road until Owen Road
 - Including Woodslea Downs Road to the west of Howe Road down to and including number 289 Woodslea Downs Road
- West along Owen Road until Wyndham Letterbox Road
- South-west along Wyndham Letterbox Road until Matura Island Fortrose Road
- North along Matura Island Fortrose Road until Matura Island Factory Road
 - Including Matura Island School Road
- West and then north along Matura Island Road until the Matura River
 - Including Matura Island Titiroa Road between Matarura Island Road and 141 Matura Island Titiroa Road
- North-east along the southern bank of the Matura River until the intersection of Ferry Factory Road and Winter Road
- North along Winter Road until Kamahi Road East
 - Including Ferry Factory Road
- West along Kamahi Road East until Shields Road
 - Including Kamahi Road East between Shields Road and Island Edendale Road
- North along Shields Road until Avon Street
- North along Avon Street until Edendale Wyndham Road

Each year, applications for enrolment in the following year from in-zone students will be sought by a date that will be published by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school. This will enable the board to assess the number of places that can be made available to students who live outside the home zone.

Special Programmes

This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a Special programme approved by the Secretary.

Out of Zone Enrolments

Each year the School Board will determine the number of places which are likely to be available in the following enrolment period(s) for the enrolment of students who live outside the home zone. The Board will publish this information by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school. The notice will indicate how


applications are to be made and will specify a date by which all applications must be received.

Applications for enrolments will be processed in the following order of priority:

| <u>First Priority</u> | This priority is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a special programme approved by the Secretary for Education. |
| <u>Second Priority</u> | will be given to applicants who are siblings of current students. |
| <u>Third Priority</u> | will be given to applicants who are siblings of former students. |
| <u>Fourth Priority</u> | will be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school. |
| <u>Fifth Priority</u> | will be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the board of the school or a child of a member of the board of the school. |
| <u>Sixth Priority</u> | will be given to all other applicants. |

If there are more applicants in any priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by ballot conducted in accordance with [instructions by the Secretary](#), under [Schedule 20, Clause 3 \(1\)](#) of the Education and Training Act 2020. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school.

Applicants may be required to give proof of In Zone address, or proof to support their application if seeking enrolment under the Out of Zone priorities.
