Place this waste into a cambro box with a bin liner provided so that they can be taken away by a School Lunch Collective team member. We actively work to compost as many scraps as we can.















Once lunch trays have been shaken out of as much food waste as possible, stack the trays back into a separate cambro box and a School

02 - Let us take your trays

Lunch Collective team member will take the box away.
