Alignment with Government priorities

1. This report supports the redesign of the vocational education and training (VET) system, which is one of your priorities for the Vocational Education portfolio.

Background

- On Monday 16 June 2025 we provided you with a draft of your Cabinet paper Proposed number and coverage of Industry Skills Boards (ISBs), revised following ministerial and agency consultation [R 1349336 refers]. This included two appendices that summarised feedback to the Tertiary Education Commission's public consultation on this issue, and provided further information on the funding model for ISBs.
- At your meeting with officials on 16 June 2025 you confirmed that you were comfortable
 with this version of the Cabinet paper and its appendices. We are now seeking formal
 approval to lodge this paper tomorrow morning, 17 June 2025, for consideration at the
 Cabinet Social Outcomes Committee meeting on 25 June 2025.
