

#### Enhancing participation

How we could structure funding to boost child participation and improve educational outcomes in early childhood education, as well as supporting parents/caregivers to participate in the labour market.

Promoting equitable outcomes

What combination of funding mechanisms could best address education and access barriers for children who would benefit.

Balancing quality, affordability and sustainability

Understanding how funding contributes to quality standards such as adult-to-child ratios, and trade-offs that are made to keep services affordable for families yet maintaining provider sustainability.


How well does the current funding system support you to deliver quality education and care to your community?
