Loburn School (3419) Proposed Enrolment Scheme

(Updated to Education and Training Act 2020)

Home Zone

All students who live within the home zone described below shall be eligible to enrol at the school.

Note that eligibility to enrol is based on the below written description of the home zone. Any associated maps are a visual representation of this description.

Addresses on both sides of boundary roads are considered in-zone unless specified otherwise.

Starting from the intersection of Birch Hill Road and Rakahuri Road;

- South along Rakahuri Road to the Rakahuri (Ashley) River
- South east along the northern bank of the Rakahuri River to a point that aligns with Fletchers Road
- North across the country from the Rakahuri River to Fletchers Road
- North along Fletchers Road to Dixons Road
- South west along Dixons Road to Wallers Road
- North east along Wallers Road to Carrs Road
- North west along Carrs Road to Carboys Road
 - Including all addresses on Doyles Road
 - Including all addresses on Carrs Road from Carboys Road up to 479 Carrs Road (on the west) and 470 Carrs Road (on the east)
- South west along Carboys Road to Pound Road
- South west along Pound Road to Loburn Whiterock Road
- South east along Loburn Whiterock Road to Hodgsons Road
 - Including all addresses on Loburn Whiterock Road from Pound Road up to 415 Loburn Whiterock Road (on the west) and 416 Loburn Whiterock Road (on the east)
 - Including all addresses on Barwells Road
- West along Hodgsons Road to Stonyflat Road
 - Including all addresses on Tawhai Drive
- North west along Stonyflat Road to Chapel Road
- West along the south side of Chapel Road to Yaxleys Road
- West across the country to the Ōkuku River
 - o Including all addresses south of Yaxleys Road only
- North along the western bank of Ōkuku River to a point due north of the intersection of Pinchgut Road and Forrestdale Road
- South from Ōkuku River to the intersection of Pinchgut Road and Forrestdale Road
 - Including all addresses on Pinchgut Road
- South east then south west along Forrestdale Road to Smiths Road
- North west along Smiths Road to Garry Road
- West along Garry Road to the Garry River
- South east along the north eastern bank of the Garry River to Garry River Road
- South east then south west along Garry River Road to Mile Road
- South east along Mile Road to Birch Hill Road
- East along Birch Hill Road to Rakahuri Road

Each year, applications for enrolment in the following year from in-zone students will be sought by a date that will be published by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school. This will enable the board to assess the number of places that can be made available to students who live outside the home zone.

Special Programmes

This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a Special programme approved by the Secretary.

Out of Zone Enrolments

Applications for enrolments will be processed in the following order of priority:

- 1. **First priority** is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a special programme approved by the Secretary for Education.
- 2. **Second priority** must be given to any applicant who is the sibling of a current student of the school.
- 3. Third priority must be given to any student who is the sibling of a former student of the school.
- 4. **Fourth priority** must be given to any applicant who is the child of a former student of the school.
- 5. **Fifth priority** must be given to any applicant who is a child of an employee of the school's board or a child of a member of the school's board.
- 6. Sixth priority must be given to all other applicants.

Before the application deadline associated with each pre-enrolment period, a Board must, by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school:

- confirm the already advertised dates for the receipt of applications and for the holding of the ballot.
- state the likely number of out of zone places that remain available.

If there are more applicants in any priority group than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by ballot conducted in accordance with <u>instructions by the Secretary</u>, under <u>Schedule 20, Clause 3 (1)</u> of the Education and Training Act 2020. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school.

Applicants may be required to give proof of In Zone address, or proof to support their application if seeking enrolment under the Out of Zone priorities.

The guidelines for development and operation of enrolment schemes are issued under Schedule 20, Clause 3 (3) of the Education and Training Act 2020 for the purpose of describing the basis on which the Secretary's powers in relation to enrolment schemes will be exercised
