


Regular excursion example:

Licensed Premises =

Outdoor space + Activity Space (indoors) + other parts of the indoor space.

Everything that is in the fenced perimeter.



Example One

Not part of the Licensed Premises

School Tennis Court / Farmyard

- An adjoining fenced-in space next to the service.
 - Used regularly by the children, weather permitting, facilitated by adults in the service.



Therefore:


- Because it is part of an ongoing planned and consistent routine of education and care, it is treated like a regular excursion.

- Using public transport or walking.
