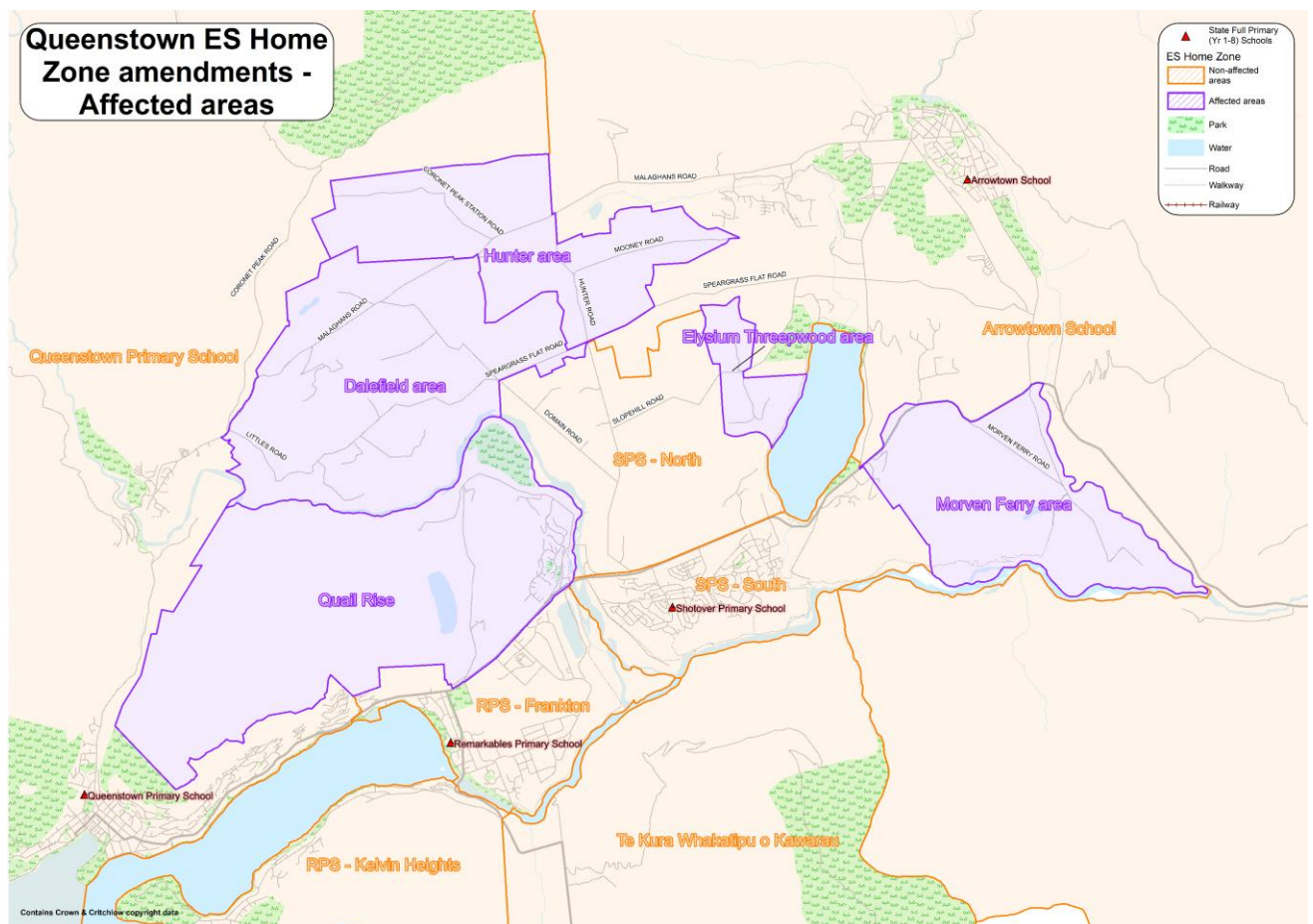
## Amendment of Enrolment Scheme

### Overview – what is changing?

The Ministry of Education is proposing to amend the existing enrolment scheme for Arrowtown School and at the same time will be amending the enrolment scheme for Remarkables Primary School and Shotover Primary School.

The Ministry is proposing to amend the Arrowtown School home zone to reflect the need to slightly rebalance the home zones between the primary schools in the Wakatipu area. The proposed scheme and full written description can be found [here](#). Changes include:

- **Dalefield, Hunter, Elysium Threepwood and Morven Ferry areas** identified in the map below to become part of the Arrowtown School home zone and be removed from Shotover Primary School.
- **Quail Rise area** to be removed from Shotover Primary school home zone and included in Remarkables Primary School home zone.

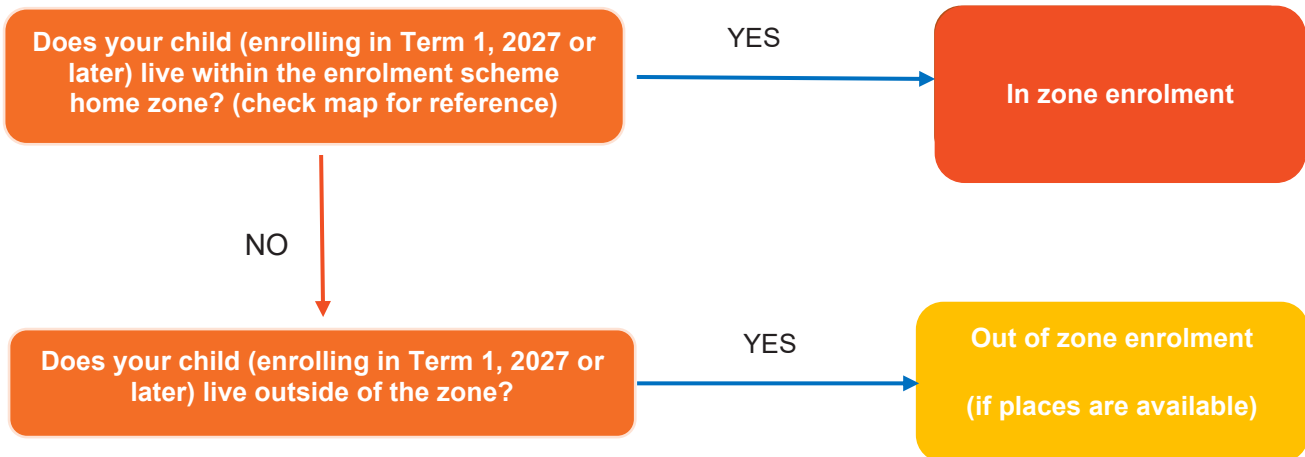




## What does this mean for my family?

Any student currently enrolled at Arrowtown School will not be impacted by the new enrolment scheme. All students enrolled (and attending school) will be entitled to continue attending Arrowtown School, irrespective of where they currently live.

The change to the home zone will affect all enrolments starting in Term 1, 2027. This includes current families who have a sibling looking to enrol at Arrowtown School and starting in Term 1, 2027 or later. The flowchart below will help you assess the student's indicative eligibility to enrol from end of 2026.



## Consultation process and timeline

The Ministry of Education is currently undertaking consultation about the proposed changes and new enrolment schemes. You can have your say by:

Consultation will run until **Thursday 18 June 2026**. The Ministry will consider all feedback and liaise with the Arrowtown School Board before making a final decision. We expect the school community to be updated about the approved scheme during Term 4. The new scheme and changes will come into effect for **Term 1, 2027** enrolments.
