

FAIRFIELD SCHOOL - LEVIN (#2838)

Enrolment Scheme Description

The commencement date of the enrolment scheme is yet to be determined.

The development and operation of enrolment schemes is undertaken under authority granted under Schedule 20 of the Education and Training Act 2020, which describes the basis on which the Secretary's powers in relation to enrolment schemes will be exercised.

Home Zone

All students who live within the home zone described below shall be entitled to enrol at the school (All numbers are inclusive).

- The boundary begins on Roslyn Road at number 56 and follows south along Roslyn Road, including the even-numbered addresses only.
- The boundary connects to Cambridge Street and follows Cambridge Street south to Montgomery Street, including Newport Street, Conway Street, Cardiff Street, Harlech Street and Highfield Place.
- The boundary follows Montgomery Street east, connecting through Winchester Street to Rugby Street.
- On Winchester Street, the boundary includes even-numbered addresses from number 150 and above, and odd-numbered addresses from number 137 and above.
- The boundary continues through Rugby Street via Eton Place, including all of Eton Place, and connects to Queenwood Road.
- On Rugby Street, the boundary includes even-numbered addresses from number 32 and above, and odd-numbered addresses from number 33 and above.
- The boundary follows Queenwood Road, including addresses from number 25 and above, then connects to Dorset Street, where only the odd-numbered addresses are included.
- The boundary continues to Bartholomew Road, including odd-numbered addresses up to and including number 150, then follows Martin Harvey Street, including odd-numbered addresses only
- From the end of Martin Harvey Street, the boundary travels through Vincent Drive Reserve and continues north, running parallel to Easton Way, encompassing Gimblett Court, Lynch Grove, Wright Grove, Aitchison Place and Webb Avenue.

- From Webb Avenue, the boundary extends southeast across land parcels to intersect Arapaepae Road at approximately number 105.
- The boundary continues across land parcels, encompassing Waihou Road and connecting to Denton Road, where only even-numbered addresses on Denton Road are included.
- From Denton Road, the boundary intersects Gladstone Road near Kohitere Scenic Reserve, including addresses from number 740 and above, and encompassing Makahika Road and Poulton Drive.
- The boundary then connects from the intersection of Waihou Road and Arapaepae Road to Roslyn Road, returning to the starting point.

Special Programmes

The school does not operate a special programme

Out of zone applications

Each year the board will determine the number of places which are likely to be available in the following year for the enrolment of students who live outside the home zone. The board will publish this information by public notice in the area served by the school. The notice will indicate how applications are to be made and will specify a date by which all applications must be received.

Applications for enrolment will be processed in the following order of priority:

- **First Priority** must be given to students who have been accepted for enrolment in the following special programme(s) run by the school and approved by the Secretary of Education up to the maximum rolls set for each programme (where applicable)
- **Second Priority:** must be given to any applicant who is the sibling of a current student of the school.
- **Third Priority:** must be given to any student who is the sibling of a former student of the school.
- **Fourth Priority:** must be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school.
- **Fifth Priority:** must be given to any applicant who is a child of an employee of the school's board, or a child of a member of the school's board.
- **Sixth Priority:** must be given to all other applicants.

If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth, fifth or sixth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group must be by ballot conducted in accordance with instructions issued by the Secretary under Schedule

20, Clause 3 of the Education Act 2020. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by appropriate public notice.

Applicants seeking second or third priority status may be required to give proof of a sibling relationship.
