Our Improved Forward Pipeline

This forward pipeline gives infrastructure suppliers better visibility of upcoming opportunities which are approved as part of Budget 2025.

Further information for Budget 2026 will be released closer to the time of scope confirmation and approval.

The Ministry's Capital Works Forward Pipeline is now able to give a wider perspective of the Ministry's pipeline of property projects, covering the majority of approved opportunities with a total contract value of \$100,000 and above. Aside from main contractors, consultants wanting to have visibility of upcoming Ministry-led procurement opportunities for project management and professional services suppliers now also benefit from this document.

Important note: The intent is not to change this information, however, updates to some of the details of these procurement processes may be required from time to time.

Capital Works Construction Pipeline

The table below reflects most of the Ministry's construction contracts with total project value of \$100K and above that are approved as part of Budget 2025 and will be tendered between the periods of **July 2026 and June 2027**. This includes open tenders offered via GETS (typically valued between \$100K and \$500K) and closed tenders for major works projects (which are typically over \$500K in value and will predominantly be offered to the Ministry's Construction Directory and/or Offsite Manufactured Buildings Panel).

Please be advised:

1. Some of the projects listed here may require multiple stages of construction delivery.
2. The 'Tender Shortlist is Identified' column indicates whether or not the Ministry has already shortlisted suppliers for this closed tender opportunity. Shortlisting of suppliers takes the following factors into account:
Past performance, capacity, capability, location, value band and financial considerations.

Important note: Whilst the intent is not to change this information, updates to some of the details of these procurement processes may be required from time to time. The table below reflects the current status of the Ministry's pipeline of projects and the earliest they would be ready to begin their procurement process. The Ministry undertakes a staged investment process where all projects go through a rigorous testing of their prioritisation and position within its Capital Investment programmes prior to tender.
