

ORMISTON JUNIOR COLLEGE (#709)

Enrolment Scheme Description

Effective from 01 January 2027

The guidelines for development and operation of enrolment schemes are issued under Schedule 20 of the Education and Training Act 2020 for the purpose of describing the basis on which the Secretary's powers in relation to enrolment schemes will be exercised.

Home Zone

All students who live within the home zone described below and shown on the attached map shall be entitled to enrol at the school.

Starting at the intersection of Chapel and Stancombe Roads, travel east along the centre of Stancombe Road (including the south side of the road only) to opposite Kensway Drive (excluded). Travel south around Sir Barry Curtis Park, east overland to the south of Multose Drive (excluded) and south along the centre of Murphys Road (160-270, 131-271 included) to Ormiston Road (168-316, 191-427/included). Travel east along the centre of Ormiston Road and travel south down Tamure Road, including addresses and roads on the west side of the road only. From the end of Tamure Road, travel east across country to include Toscana Drive and Rufina Way. From there, travel southeast across country to the intersection of Michael Boshier Way and Redoubt Road. Travel south down Redoubt Road, including even addresses 600-632 only.

From 600 Redoubt Road, continue northwest across country to Murphys Park Drive. Travel west down Murphys Park Drive to Murphys Road, including roads and addresses on the north side only. Travel northwest across country to cross Drumbuoy Drive (included), then over to the corner of Castlebane Drive (34-64 Castlebane Drive and Bunbeg Crescent excluded). Travel west down Castlebane Drive and Repehina Road, then north on Donegal Park Drive (41/42 and up included; 35 and 68 Ksenia Drive included). Travel west down Puoro Street and cross Quattro Avenue (14/15 and up included), cross Slipper Avenue (excluded), and meet Chapel Road (69-163 odd numbers only included). Travel north along the centre of Chapel Road, back to the starting point.

Proof of residence within the home zone will be required.

Each year, applications for enrolment in the following year from in-zone students will be sought by a date which will be published in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. This will enable the board to assess the number of places which can be made available to students who live outside the home zone.

Additional Entitlement to Enrol

This provision has been approved under Section 75 1(a) of the Education and Training Act 2020.

For families of currently enrolled students whose addresses become out of zone as a result of the amendment to this enrolment scheme commencing 1 January 2027 there is an Additional Entitlement to Enrol Provision.

Section 75 of the Education and Training Act 2020 states that;

“the Secretary may authorise an enrolment scheme to permit a student to enrol at the school as if the student lived in the home zone of the school if, -

(a) in the case of an existing enrolment scheme whose home zone is amended, —

- i. the student lives outside the amended home zone; and
- ii. the student has a sibling who is enrolled at the school at the time that the amendment is implemented; and
- iii. the sibling, at the time that the amendment is implemented, lives inside the home zone as it was before the amendment; and
- iv. the student, at the time of enrolment, lives inside the home zone as it was before the amendment:

The **Transitional arrangements (“Grandparenting”)** section within the **Guidelines for the development and operation of enrolment schemes for State Schools** further clarifies that in order to enrol as if the student lived in the home zone:

- i. The sibling must also still be enrolled at the school at the time that the student wants to enrol

The properties described in the addresses below and in the map (proposed area to be grandparented) shall be deemed to form part of the home zone, provided a child residing at that address has a sibling who attended the school in 2026, and a sibling currently attends the school. When the family living at the address in 2026 ceases residing at the address, the property shall cease to be part of the home zone.

If applying for enrolment under this part of the Enrolment Scheme, the sibling's name and evidence of a sibling relationship may be required by the school. Section 75 of the Education and Training Act 2020 sets out the definition of a "sibling" for these purposes.

The school will maintain a list of students enrolled at the time of the implementation of the enrolment scheme change by the Board in order to enable determination of eligibility to enrol under this provision.

Out of Zone Enrolments

Each year the board will determine the number of places which are likely to be available in the following year for the enrolment of students who live outside the home zone. The board will publish this information by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. The notice will indicate how applications are to be made and will specify a date by which all applications must be received.

Applications for enrolment will be processed in the following order of priority:

- **First Priority** This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a Special programme approved by the Secretary.
- **Second Priority** will be given to applicants who are siblings of current students.
- **Third Priority** will be given to applicants who are siblings of former students.

- **Fourth Priority** will be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school.
- **Fifth Priority** will be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the board of the school or a child of a member of the board of the school.
- **Sixth Priority** will be given to all other applicants.

If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth, or fifth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by a ballot conducted in accordance with instructions issued by the Secretary under Schedule 20 of the Education and Training Act 2020. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school.

Applicants seeking second or third priority status may be required to give proof of a sibling relationship.
